



Masonry is a charitable organization in its essence. As a reflection of this, we contribute regularly to a long-standing Masonic charity known as the Widows and Orphans Fund. This charity assists the widows and under-age children of brother Masons who have passed on. We also have a charity fund in place for brothers of our lodge and other local lodges who may need emergency assistance. Our lodge has a small amount of medical assistance equipment (hospital beds, walkers, crutches, wheelchairs, etc.) that we provide at no cost to citizens in need. In addition, we also provide a scholarship fund for area high school seniors. We also regularly contribute to Project Homesafe and Gallatin Cares. Project Homesafe is a secure shelter for battered women and children. Gallatin Cares offers low cost clothing and homegoods for the less fortunate.

During the holidays, we have a program that provides fruit baskets to widows of our departed lodge brothers. While this service may not provide a necessity, it is a way to honor the wives of men who served with us and to remind them we have not forgotten them. The ladies are grateful for this service and enjoy visiting with us.

To assist us in the projects that have been listed, we host fund-raisers throughout the year. The largest of these is our annual golf tournament. Our hope is that it will continue to grow from year to year. We would appreciate your help in making this hope a reality. The sponsorship levels are listed below. Sponsorship Levels:
